- Holding regular meetings of the Modern Slavery Action Team (comprising of the HR
 Director, the Operations Director and the Supply Chain Director) to discuss areas within the
 business and its supply chains which are most likely to be at risk of modern slavery, and
 develop appropriate strategies for addressing these risks.
- Halewood Artisanal Spirits will continue to audit any new and existing recruitment agencies
 used by the business for the provision of a temporary workforce, to ensure compliance with
 the Modern Slavery Act 2015 (MSA).
- Halewood Artisanal Spirits will continue to ensure a commitment to adhere to the MSA from all suppliers to the business, confirming same by way of written condition in any contracts which Halewood Artisanal Spirits may enter for the procurement of goods or services. HAS(UK)Ltd Standard Terms of Purchase and Standard Terms of Sale of Goods continue to highlight the compliance requirements.
- Halewood Artisanal Spirits will continue to provide information to the workforce by way of
 highlighting its MSA Policy to all new personnel, making it available on the intranet and the
 displaying of informative posters highlighting the warning signs that a person may be a
 victim of human trafficking. We continue to advise the workforce to contact their line
 manager or our HR department in confidence if they have any concerns. We continue to
 provide this information translated into other languages for the benefit of colleagues from
 other countries.
